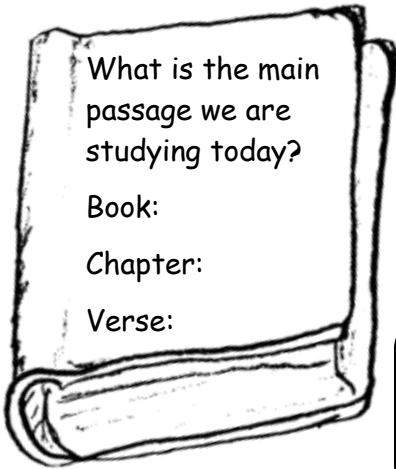

The SON OF MAN Is Resurrected – Monday

A person who had been crucified was either left on the cross for a few days, or thrown outside the city. Family members could ask for the body, but this wish was not always granted. Mark's Gospel says that Joseph "boldly" asked for Jesus' body. Joseph was willing to make a public statement that he was a follower of Jesus by asking for Jesus' body. Remember, he's a member of the very council that sent Jesus to the cross, but Joseph cared more about Jesus than what anyone else might say of him.

Application:

None of us knows what we would've done if we had been present at the crucifixion and burial of Jesus, but we can see how we respond to those who don't like Jesus today.

The SON OF MAN Is Resurrected - Tuesday

➤ Say the memory verse to mom, dad, or older sibling.

Pray: Dear Father, help me to understand what I read in Your Word.

Read: Luke 23:55-24:7

Joseph and Nicodemus (*John 19:39*) had to quickly prepare Jesus' body for burial because Friday was coming to a close and the Sabbath was about to begin. Who was standing by watching Joseph and Nicodemus (*v 55; Mark 15:47*)? _____

Evidently, they thought that Jesus' body needed more spices, but it would have to be finished in a couple of days. When did they come back to the tomb (*24:1*)? Day _____ Time _____

Application:

Other than the guards who witnessed the resurrection, who chose to lie about Jesus' resurrection rather than believe (*Matthew 28:11-15*), these women were the first to know about Jesus' resurrection. Even though the disciples had spent so much time with Jesus, they were not the first to know about Jesus' resurrection.

Just because you go to church all of the time does not mean that you are a child of God. You must believe in Jesus' death/resurrection and trust in Him to save you from your sin. If you've done this, thank God for making Himself known to you that you might believe and be saved!

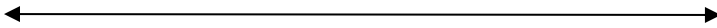

Application:

None of us saw Jesus on the cross, laid in the tomb, or His resurrected body. However, we have read about these things in God's Word, written down by the instruction of the Holy Spirit through the testimony of Jesus' 1st disciples. God is calling us to believe these things by grace through faith. John wrote at the end of his gospel these words, *John 20:30-31^(ESV) - ¹³⁰ Now Jesus did many other signs in the presence of the disciples, which are not written in this book; ³¹ but **these are written so that YOU may believe that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God, and that by believing you may have life in his name.**" Do you believe? _____*

The SON OF MAN Is Resurrected - Thursday

➤ Say the memory verse to mom, dad, or older sibling.

Pray: Dear Father, help me to understand what I read in Your Word.

Read: Luke 24:13-27

Application:

Even though these men knew the Old Testament and had either heard from others, or seen with their own eyes, the works and teachings of Jesus, they still did not understand how Jesus could be the promised Messiah. Maybe this is like you today. You've been taught about Jesus from the Old and New Testaments and shown how Jesus' life, death, resurrection and glorification are the focus of the whole Bible. Yet, you still don't believe.

Jesus didn't do more miracles so that these two men would believe. Rather, He taught them the Bible and talked about what He'd already done and then the Spirit opened their eyes to understand.

Romans 10:17^(ESV) – "So faith comes from hearing, and hearing through the word of Christ."

The SON OF MAN Is Resurrected – Friday

Application:

Slowly, more and more of Jesus' disciples were seeing Jesus with their own eyes. This coupled with the teaching of the Old Testament "burned" their hearts. *Hebrews 4:12^(ESV) – "For the word of God is living and active, sharper than any two-edged sword, piercing to the division of soul and of spirit, of joints and of marrow, and discerning the thoughts and intentions of the heart."*

While Jesus was on earth, people did not even notice! After His resurrection, it became clear to His followers by a special work of the Spirit. If you are not trusting in Jesus to save you from your sins, ask God to open your eyes to the truth just like He did to Jesus' disciples.
