





God Ordains the Passover – Monday

- Say the memory verse to mom, dad, or older sibling.

Pray: Dear Father, help me to understand what I read in Your Word.

Read: Exodus 11:4-8

The LORD God sent a 10th and final plague on Egypt. It would be during this 10th plague that God would redeem a people for His name by delivering Israel from slavery and defeat Egypt, glorifying His Name among all the nations.

Pray

Dear LORD God, You multiplied Your wonders in Egypt and showed Your great power. The gods of the nations are nothing before You!

What did Moses tell Pharaoh would happen in this final plague?

Application

Sometimes it is easy to forget just how powerful God is. We have problems that seem so big to us and we are tempted to think there is nothing God can do.

Talk to a parent about a problem or hard thing you are going through right now. How does it help you to trust the LORD in this situation as you think about God's power to defeat Egypt and free His people? _____

God Ordains the Passover - Tuesday

- Say the memory verse to mom, dad, or older sibling.

Pray: Dear Father, help me to understand what I read in Your Word.

Read: Exodus 12:2-4

God institutes the Passover and Feast of Unleavened Bread.

What day of the year would the Passover mark?

- Beginning of the year
- Middle of the year
- End of the year

Draw what every household had to set apart for God.

Pray

Dear LORD God, You gave life to all people, and Jesus died as the Lamb of God for the sins of Your people to give them NEW life. Just as the Passover would be the beginning of a new year for Israel, so one's salvation from sin is the beginning of a new way of life for God's children. Thank You for making a way for me to have forgiveness of my sins and a new life in Jesus' righteousness.

Application

Israel only put the blood of the lamb on the doorposts of their houses during the 1st Passover, but they were to make an animal sacrifice every Passover after leaving Egypt to remind them that only God can give new life.

In a similar way, Jesus died once for His people's sins, but we're commanded to regularly take Communion as a reminder that Jesus died to give us new life. If you're trusting in Jesus for salvation, you should live like Jesus. Ask your parent if they see new life in you.

God Ordains the Passover – Wednesday

- Say the memory verse to mom, dad, or older sibling.

Pray: Dear Father, help me to understand what I read in Your Word.

Read: Exodus 12:3-6

The lamb had to be "perfect."

Pray

Dear LORD God, You saved Israel from death by the blood of the Passover lamb. Today, You save people from eternal death by the blood of Jesus Christ, Your Passover Lamb. I thank You for Jesus, the Lamb of God who takes away sin.

Application

John the Baptist told the disciples that Jesus was "the Lamb of God who takes away the sin of the world." Jesus was the sacrifice for sin because he was sinless. He died to pay for the sins of others.

If sin is so bad that God sent His Son to die in our place to save us from death, what should be our attitude about doing wrong?

For how many days would the Israelites watch this Passover lamb to make sure there was nothing wrong with it? ____ days

God Ordains the Passover - Thursday

- Say the memory verse to mom, dad, or older sibling.

Pray: Dear Father, help me to understand what I read in Your Word.

Read: Exodus 12:6-7

By faith, each Israelite had to put the lamb's blood on the doorposts of their houses in order to live.

Pray


Dear LORD God, help me to trust in Jesus Christ as my Passover Lamb, believing that His shed blood will save me from the punishment of my sin.

Application

Most boys and girls know that they sin. Some know they are born sinners. But do you understand that sin keeps you away from the holy God?

Matthew 26:28 (ESV) - Jesus said, "...This is my blood of the covenant, which is poured out for many for the forgiveness of sins."

Without blood, God will not forgive your sins. Knowing Jesus gave His blood for us shows us that sin is a big deal. Have you asked God to forgive you of your sin? _____

God Ordains the Passover – Friday

- Say the memory verse to mom, dad, or older sibling.

Pray: Dear Father, help me to understand what I read in Your Word.

Read: Exodus 12:8-10

All of the Passover lamb was to be eaten or burned by fire. Also, the meal was to be eaten with bitter herbs and unleavened bread.

Pray

Dear LORD God, I thank You for Jesus that He died for me so I might live for You.

Application

God often uses leaven to picture the presence of sin. Like leaven in bread dough that makes it bigger, a small sin can soon lead us into bigger sin.

The bread Israel would eat on this special night would have no leaven, so it would be flat.

Each part of the meal helped Israel remember what God had done. Match the part of the meal to its meaning.

Lamb	Bitter slavery
Flat bread	God will free them from Egypt
Bitter herbs	Remove all sin
Traveling clothes	Blood will save God's people

Pray: Dear Father, help me to understand what I read in Your Word.

Read: Exodus 12:11-13

Exodus 12:13 ^(ESV) -The blood shall be a sign for you, on the houses where you are. And when I see the blood, I will pass over you, and no plague will befall you to destroy you, when I strike the land of Egypt.

Pray

Dear LORD God, You are the LORD. You are God, and there is no god besides You. I praise You for Your power. You have defeated our enemies and rescued us forever! Help me to spread the word about Your Son Jesus, the Lamb of God, every opportunity I get.
