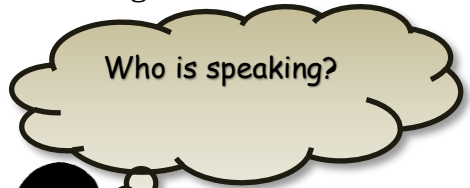
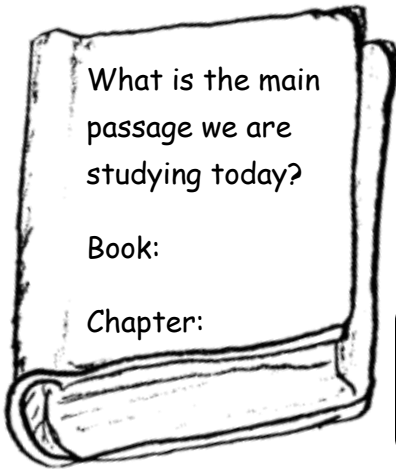

God Establishes the Priesthood - Monday

- Say the memory verse to mom, dad, or older sibling.

Pray: Dear Father, help me to understand what I read in Your Word.

Read: *Leviticus 9:22-24; Exodus 28:1*

God showed that He accepted the offerings. He also set apart a family to serve as priests in the tabernacle ministry. Their former way of life had ended. They were now devoted to God and would serve the LORD.
