God Is Chosen by Israel - Monday

Say the memory verse to mom, dad, or older sibling.

Pray: Dear Father, help me to understand what I read in Your Word.

Read or Listen: Joshua 23:1-3

Joshua was aware of the challenge faced by the Israelites as they would continue to settle the land and remove the Canaanites. Therefore, when he was almost 110 years old, he warned the people of the danger of living among the Canaanites and reminded them of what God had done for them. God had fought for His people and had promised to drive out the rest of the people of the Promised Land.

Meditation: 1. Joshua's age is mentioned 2 times in these 3 verses. Why do you think his <i>"old</i> <i>age"</i> is important? (<i>See Deut. 5:16, 32-</i> <i>33.</i>)	"And I am sure of this, that he who began a good work in you will bring it to completion at the day of Jesus Christ." Philippians 1:6	,

Application: God made a promise to Israel, and God faithfully kept His word. Israel was given rest in the Promised Land. Ever since Adam's sin in *Genesis 3*, God has promised to bring rest from the fight of sin (*Genesis 3:15*). The picture of Israel's rest in the Promised Land is a reminder to us that God will be faithful to give us rest from sin as well. *Revelation 21:3-4* shows us that God will be faithful to His promise. What will this "rest" from sin look like?

God Is Chosen by Israel - Tuesday

Say the memory verse to mom, dad, or older sibling.

Pray: Dear Father, help me to understand what I read in Your Word.

Read or Listen: Joshua 23:4-8

After talking about the good that God had done, Joshua encouraged the people to "*be very courageous to keep and to do all that is written in the Book of the Law of Moses*". But because Israel was still living among the Canaanites, Joshua knew Israel needed a special reminder to be pure because they were surrounded by idolaters.

Application: Joshua said to "*be strong and courageous*" in conquering the land. Paul says to "*be always of good courage*" in conquering sin (*2 Cor 5:4-10*). Joshua told Israel that God would fight their battles. Paul said that the Spirit is given to us to fight against sin. "*Whether we are home* (alive) or *absent* (dead)...to ______ *Him*" (*2 Cor 5:9*).

God Is Chosen by Israel - Wednesday

Say the memory verse to mom, dad, or older sibling.

Pray: Dear Father, help me to understand what I read in Your Word.

Read or Listen: Joshua 23:11-13

Joshua's instructions were coupled with a warning. If Israel did not "cling" to God (v 8) and instead would "cling" to the Canaanites and marry them (v 12), God would not drive out the Canaanites (v 13). If Israel chose the wickedness of the Canaanites, God would allow the Canaanites to be a big problem to the

Israelites. Israel's punishment would be that the Canaanites would so corrupt them that eventually they would lose the Promised Land.

Meditation:

True or False

Israel was allowed to marry the Canaanites.

Moses also gave warnings to Israel before he died. Which verses in *Deuteronomy* sound a little bit like *Joshua 23:11-13? Deut 28:1-14 Deut 28:15-68 Deut 33:13-17*

What could Israel do to keep the Canaanites from tempting them to worship false gods (*v* 11)? God Is Chosen by Israel - Thursday

> Say the memory verse to mom, dad, or older sibling.

Pray: Dear Father, help me to understand what I read in Your Word.

Read or Listen: Joshua 23:14-16

Joshua promised that just as God had been faithful to keep His promises of blessing, He would keep His promises of cursing. How Israel responded to the challenge of the Canaanites would determine whether they enjoyed God's promised blessings or struggled against God's promised curses.

Meditation:

1. How many times did Joshua tell Israel that God had been faithful to His word (*v* 14-15)?

2. What did Joshua say would happen to Israel if they were not faithful (v 15-16)?

3. *True* or *False* God will be just as faithful cursing Israel for their sin as He was in blessing Israel (*v* 16).

Application:

How many of God's promises to you will He keep? ______ Joshua told Israel that God would be faithful to His promise of cursing them for their sin. What similar promise is given to Christians in *Hebrews 12:6? "For the Lord _______ the one he loves, and ______ every son whom he receives."* What does *Hebrews 12:11* say is the purpose of God's discipline?

God Is Chosen by Israel - Friday

> Say the memory verse to mom, dad, or older sibling.

Pray: Dear Father, help me to understand what I read in Your Word.

Read or Listen: Joshua 24:13-16, 18, 20-21, 23-24

Joshua knew that the people had to choose whether they were going to serve God or the gods of the Canaanites. In *verse 15*, Joshua told the people, *"Choose for yourselves this day whom you will serve...but as for me and my house, we will serve the LORD."* Joshua was committed that his family would follow the LORD, regardless of what the rest of Israel did.

True or *False* In order for Israel to "*put away the foreign gods*" they had to be worshiping them already.

True or *False* Every time Joshua told Israel to get rid of the false gods, Israel promised to get rid of all the false gods.

Application:

For a time, Israel was committed to following God. They faithfully followed the LORD during the days of Joshua (24:31), but eventually, Israel would forget to cling to God's Law and worship the Canaanites' gods instead.

God Is Chosen by Israel - Saturday

Say the memory verse to mom, dad, or older sibling.

Pray: Dear Father, help me to understand what I read in Your Word.

Read or Listen: Joshua 24:29-31

Even though there is no question written at the end of this book, there should be some questions in your mind as you come to the end of this book: "Who will lead Israel next?" At the end of Moses' life, God chose Joshua to lead Israel, but there is no leader chosen at the end of Joshua's life. In fact, if you read on into the book of Judges 1:1, you will see that Israel asked this same question.

Here is a second question you should ask: *"Will Israel continue to serve the LORD now that Joshua is dead?"* Once again, the book of Judges will answer this question.

Meditation:

3. Was Israel faithful to the LORD as long as the elders who served with Joshua were alive (*v. 31*)?
