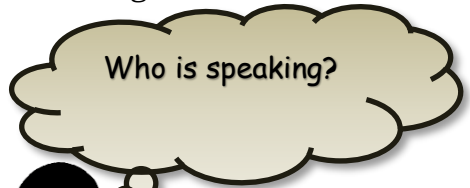
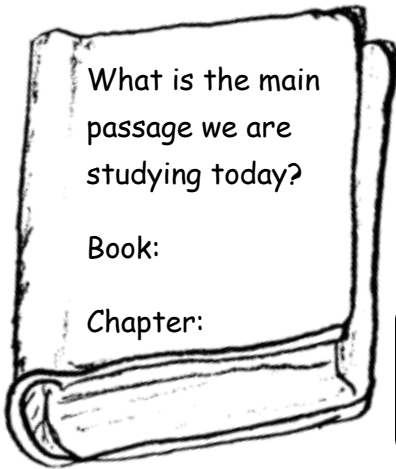

## God Ordains the Day of Atonement - Monday

**Pray:** Dear Father, help me to understand what I read in Your Word.

**Read:** *Leviticus 16:1-22; 1 John 2:2; 4:10; Hebrews 2:17*

### Pray

Dear LORD God, You are gracious and merciful, showing forgiveness to all who have put their trust in the atoning sacrifice of the LORD Jesus Christ. I praise You for Jesus, whose blood covers my sins.

## God Ordains the Day of Atonement – Tuesday

- Say the memory verse to mom, dad, or older sibling.

**Pray:** Dear Father, help me to understand what I read in Your Word.

**Read:** *Leviticus 16:6, 11-14*

Before Aaron could make atonement for others, he first had to repent of and make a sacrifice to atone for his own sins.

### Pray

Dear LORD God, You are holy! When I see how Aaron came into Your holy presence, I know that sin is a very big deal to You. Without Jesus' blood, I know I could not come into Your holy presence and live.

### Application

Aaron was the high priest, but like everyone else he was a sinner. He could not come before the LORD until His sin had been atoned for. If you have trusted in Jesus Christ's death and atoning blood to cover your sins, you may come to God ANY day and as many times a day as you like in prayer.

How will this truth affect the way you pray, and how often you pray?

What did Aaron offer as a sin offering for himself to make atonement (vv 6, 11)? \_\_\_\_\_

What did Aaron take from off the fire with some incense inside the veil (the Most Holy Place) (v 12)? \_\_\_\_\_

Aaron could not serve others until his own sins had been covered. The Ark of the Covenant represented the Law that Aaron had not kept perfectly. The Mercy Seat with blood sprinkled upon it would turn away God's wrath against Aaron's sins.

## God Ordains the Day of Atonement - Wednesday

- Say the memory verse to mom, dad, or older sibling.

**Pray:** Dear Father, help me to understand what I read in Your Word.

**Read:** *Leviticus 16:7-10, 15-19*

With his own sins atoned for, Aaron could now make atonement for the rest of Israel.

### Pray

Dear LORD God, thank You for pouring out Your wrath on Jesus, Your Son, for my sins. May I always live remembering what He did for me in bearing my sins in His body, dying in my place, and carrying my sins far away from me.

### Application

Jesus Christ took the punishment of God for the sins of those who would be saved through Him. He died "outside" of the city like an outcast so that we could live with God and be loved as His sons.

When a person turns from sin and trusts in Christ's atoning sacrifice, all of their sins are forgiven forever. This is the reason Christians do not have a Day of Atonement.

*Jesus paid it all; all to Him I owe.  
Sin had left a crimson stain,  
He washed it white as snow.*

The blood of the animal Aaron sacrificed was taken inside the veil (the Most Holy Place) and just like the bull's blood, it would be sprinkled upon the Mercy Seat (Atonement Cover). When the LORD saw the blood, His wrath was turned away.

# God Ordains the Day of Atonement - Thursday

- Say the memory verse to mom, dad, or older sibling.

**Pray:** Dear Father, help me to understand what I read in Your Word.

**Read:** *Leviticus 16:29-30*

The Day of Atonement was to be a statute in Israel forever.

## Pray

Dear LORD God, atonement makes sinners clean from sin. Thank You, Jesus, for cleansing me from my sins. I know I can come to You every day and ask for forgiveness and be perfectly clean!

## Application

*1 John 1:9 (ESV) - If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.*

## God Ordains the Day of Atonement – Friday

- Say the memory verse to mom, dad, or older sibling.

**Pray:** Dear Father, help me to understand what I read in Your Word.

**Read:** *Leviticus 16:31*

The Day of Atonement was also marked by what Israel would not do on that day.

### Pray

Dear LORD God, thank You Jesus, the Lord of the Sabbath, for giving me rest in You. I know that Your sacrifice is all I need to be forgiven eternally and so I am trusting in You alone for eternal life.

### Application

We learned:

- *To praise God for making a way of atonement for our sins through Jesus' death on the cross.*
- *Trust that God's forgiveness lasts forever.*
- *To prepare our hearts by confessing our sins before coming into the presence of God in prayer.*

### The Day of Atonement

Jesus, our atoning sacrifice, finished the work of salvation from God's wrath. When He offered Himself, He sat down at the right hand of God because there was no more work to do.

There is no work for you or me to do to pay for our sins, either. The work of God, Jesus said, is to "believe on the One He sent." Have you believed on the LORD Jesus Christ?

The only work God will accept as payment for your sins is to repent and believe the Gospel.

This week you learned about the Day of Atonement in Israel, what atonement means, and why atonement is still important today.

### The Day of Atonement

The sacrifices Israel brought were a reminder of their sinfulness. But God also revealed His mercy by providing the Day of Atonement, when all Israelites could be cleansed from the sins and impurity of the previous year.
