





Jesus Enters Jerusalem as King – Monday

- Say the memory verse to mom, dad, or older sibling.

Pray: Dear Father, help me to understand what I read in Your Word.

Read: *Matthew 21:1-3*

The Passover was about a week away, and Jews were coming from all over to Jerusalem to observe it. Jesus of Nazareth was coming, too!

Pray

Dear LORD God, You know the end from the beginning. You have made known to Your people all we need to know about the coming of King Jesus.

What did Jesus send the disciples to get? (Draw it.)

Application

Jesus came to Jerusalem to give His life as a sacrifice for sin. Jesus is the promised King of Israel—the Messiah, or Christ. Coming to the city in a special way would fulfill prophecy.

Why do you think God gave Israel prophecies about the coming of Messiah? _____

Jesus Enters Jerusalem as King - Tuesday

- Say the memory verse to mom, dad, or older sibling.

Pray: Dear Father, help me to understand what I read in Your Word.

Read: *Matthew 21:4-5; Zechariah 9:9*

Jesus fulfilled Bible prophecy during His first coming.

Pray

Dear LORD God, You are so good to give us the Bible. In it, we see Your promises and prophecies. You always do what You say You will, and for that I praise You!

What sign did God give to Israel so that they would know when the promised King had come? (Draw it.)

Application

The history of the world is no mystery to God. He knows everything about everything. Sometimes He tells His people what will happen in advance. We call that "prophecy."

Jesus Enters Jerusalem as King - Wednesday

- Say the memory verse to mom, dad, or older sibling.

Pray: Dear Father, help me to understand what I read in Your Word.

Read: Matthew 21:6-11; Revelation 19:11-16

"And the crowds that went before him and that followed him were shouting, 'Hosanna to the Son of David!'"

Kings rode on a horse or mule, but Jesus rode a donkey. Jesus didn't come to set up His earthly kingdom on that day. He came to bear the burden of sin, to set up His kingdom in His disciples' lives.

What will Jesus be riding when He comes to set up His earthly kingdom (Revelation 19:11-16)?

What names will Jesus be called on the day He returns?

Pray

Dear LORD God, Your Son Jesus is the promised Messiah!

Thank you for keeping your promise to send the savior!

Jesus rode into Jerusalem and was hailed as King! (Color it.)

- Say the memory verse to mom, dad, or older sibling.

Read: Matthew 21:12-17

Dear LORD God, worship of You is important.


Jesus was angry about the wrong ways people were acting at the temple. Teach me, LORD, how to worship You in ways that please You.

Application

God knows your heart. He knows what you think and feel. He deserves to be loved and adored.

Each Sunday we have a chance to come together with other worshippers and praise the LORD and think and learn of Him. What can you do this Sunday to worship God in ways that please Him?

Jesus saw how the worship of God was being ruined by greed, & He cleared out the evildoers.

Jesus Enters Jerusalem as King - Friday

- Say the memory verse to mom, dad, or older sibling.

Pray: Dear Father, help me to understand what I read in Your Word.

Read: Matthew 21:23-27

Not everyone was happy to see Jesus. The chief priests and the elders of the people confronted the LORD as he taught in the temple.

Pray

Dear LORD God, You have given all authority in heaven and earth to Jesus, Your Son. He has commanded His people to make disciples of all nations. LORD Jesus, make me an obedient witness for You!

Application

Jesus is God. He is our authority, our King. When even a human king tells his people to do this or that, they must obey. How much more should we obey King Jesus who is God and sinless humanity? Jesus commanded his disciples to "make disciples." Who could you tell the stories of Jesus that you have been learning this year? _____

What question did they ask Jesus?

Jesus said he would answer their question, if they first answered his question about John the Baptist.

Did they answer His question?

Yes or No

The leaders could not admit that John the Baptist was sent from God because they did not obey his teaching. They also could not deny that he was not a prophet, because all the other Jews believed that he was. So, they lied. They said, "We don't know." Since they did not answer Jesus, neither did He answer them.

Jesus Enters Jerusalem as King - Saturday

- Say the memory verse to mom, dad, or older sibling.

Pray: Dear Father, help me to understand what I read in Your Word.

Read: Matthew 22:41-46; Revelation 19:11-16

The Pharisees did not believe that Jesus was the Christ, but they knew that the Christ would come from the line of King David.

Pray

Dear LORD God, I thank You for Jesus who is both LORD and Christ. He is God and He is my savior! I will worship Him. I will obey Him. I will tell others about Him.

King David knew that the Christ would come through his family, yet he called this descendant, Lord.
