Peter and John Preach the Gospel - Monday

Say the memory verse to mom, dad, or older sibling.

Pray: Dear Father, help me to understand what I read in Your Word.

Read: Acts 3:1-10 → The Miracle

The murderers of Jesus hated Jesus' name because it continually proclaimed His authority. Not only did the chief priests and elders hate Jesus' name, but they also hated those who trusted in that name. What did Peter and John do in the name of Jesus (v 6)?

True OR False The man by the temple was blind.

Because the afternoon sacrifice was offered at this time of day, the temple was likely crowded with those who had come to make the sacrifice and offer prayers. Peter did the miracle in Jesus' name to show that only Jesus had the power and authority to heal the man.

The crowds were amazed by what happened. They realized that the man they saw "walking and praising God" (1:9) was the same one who had been begging by the Beautiful Gate.

Who are you most like when you are reminded of God's power and authority over your life?

Chief Priests - Don't want to think about His rule over you? Crowd - Like His care for you but don't want to serve Him? Lame man - Worship Him as Lord and Savior?

Peter and John Preach the Gospel - Tuesday

Say the memory verse to mom, dad, or older sibling.

Pray: Dear Father, help me to understand what I read in Your Word.

Read: Acts 3:11-26 → Peter's Sermon

The crowd gathered around Peter and John because they thought the miracle was cool, and they wanted to see more. But as Peter preached, they were given something better than what they were looking for, just like the lame man.

Who did Peter say Jesus was (v 13)?

This crowd of devout Jews said they worshiped the same God of Abraham, Isaac and Jacob. Yet, Peter says that a Roman was more concerned about Jesus' power and authority than them. What Roman did Peter mention (v 13)?

Then Peter shows how wrong they were in their thinking about Jesus by setting up several contrasts (vv 14-18):

Peter told the crowd that repentance, turning back to Jesus as king, would bring four things (vv 19-26):

- 1) Sins would be \mathbf{b} \mathbf{o} (v 19)2) Times of \mathbf{r} in God's presence (v 20)
- 3) Christ's return, r_____ of all things under His control and His Kingdom established (v 21)
- 4) They would be **b______** (*v 26*) and NOT **d**_____(v 23) by God's judgment for ignoring His Prophet.

Peter and John Preach the Gospel - Wednesday

Say the memory verse to mom, dad, or older sibling.

Pray: Dear Father, help me to understand what I read in Your Word.

Read: Acts 4:1-4 → People's Response

How did the religious leaders respond to Peter's sermon?

- a. They rejoiced in hearing the fulfillment of prophecy in Jesus' death and resurrection.
- b. They asked Peter and John to come to the temple to teach them more about Jesus.
- c. They were annoyed at hearing more about Jesus.

What did the religious leaders do to keep Peter and John from talking about Jesus?

- a. Gave them a banquet to keep their mouths full of food.
- b. Removed them from the temple by arresting them.
- c. Had Pilate crucify Peter and John

While Peter and John preached in the temple, the religious leaders became worried and jealous, and they wanted relations with the Roman Empire to remain stable. Furthermore, they didn't like these untrained men contradicting their teachings.

You've seen throughout the whole Bible how Satan has tried to stop God's eternal plan of redemption through His Son. Even though Satan has not been able to stop it up to this point, he made another attempt to keep the gospel from the crowd.

Was Satan able to keep the crowd from repenting?

We saw 3,000 people added to the original 120 believers after Peter's 1^{st} sermon. God worked through Peter's 2^{nd} sermon as well, even though they were arrested, and many more were added to the church.

How many men were now in the early church (v 4)?

Peter and John Preach the Gospel - Thursday

Say the memory verse to mom, dad, or older sibling.

Pray: Dear Father, help me to understand what I read in Your Word.

Read: Acts 4:5-18 → Trial and Warning

The Sanhedrin was a seventy-one-member council. Among those present were Annas, and the current high priest Caiaphas, both of whom had been involved in Jesus' death (John 18).

When Jesus was arrested, every disciple ran away. When Jesus was on trial, Peter denied even knowing Jesus. Now, Peter is on trial before the same group of wicked men. Acts 4:8 tells us how Peter was able to boldly stand before these same men without fear this time. Why was Peter so bold (v 8)?

The H_______ S______'s presence

Peter wanted to make sure they knew who Jesus was. Circle everything that Peter said to describe Jesus to them.

Jesus is the Good Shepherd. Jesus lived in Nazareth.

Jesus is the Christ/Messiah. Jesus died in a chariot crash.

Peter not only preached Jesus' power to heal the body but also preached Him as the only one who can heal men's souls. The Sanhedrin was confused how to respond to the apostles. Unlike themselves, the apostles had received no formal training but the apostles still spoke boldly before the highest Jewish officials.

The Sanhedrin also realized that they could not deny what had happened in Jesus' name as the man who had been healed was standing in their presence.

Rather than punishing the apostles or repenting of their sins, the Sanhedrin just gave Peter and John this command (v 18):

Peter and John Preach the Gospel - Friday

> Say the memory verse to mom, dad, or older sibling.

Pray: Dear Father, help me to understand what I read in Your Word.

Read: Acts 4:19-22 → Apostles' Response

The Sanhedrin thought that their command to the apostles to no longer talk about Jesus would scare them enough to silence the apostles. But Peter and John were not easily scared at this point. In fact, Peter and John said that the religious leaders were the ones who were really on trial.

The apostles had to decide who they were going to obey. What were their two options (v 19)?

The Sanhedrin's plan didn't work. Instead of the apostles being afraid of them, they were afraid! Of whom were they afraid (v 21)?
This will not be the last time that the Sanhedrin will try to threaten the apostles' witness of Jesus Christ to the crowds, and the Holy Spirit continued to give the apostles boldness and power to do exactly what Jesus had commanded.
Paul would one day write <i>Romans 8:31-39</i> to encourage the growing church in the midst of opposition.
Romans 8:31, 38-39 (ESV) — 31 What then shall we say to these things If God is for us, who can be us? 38 For I am sure that neither nor life, nor angels nor, nor things present nor things to come, nor, 39 nor height nor depth, nor anything else in creation, will be able to separate us from the love of God in Christ our

Peter and John Preach the Gospel - Saturday

Say the memory verse to mom, dad, or older sibling.

Pray: Dear Father, help me to understand what I read in Your Word.

Read: Acts 4:23-31 → Believers Pray & God Answers

After hearing about what had happened to Peter and John, those present joined in prayer that Christ's name would continue to be exalted. Their prayer began with praise to God.

How did they describe God (v 24)?

The believers now recognized that the crucifixion of Jesus by these wicked men was not an accident. Who did they say planned Jesus' death (v 28)?

Just as God had planned Jesus' crucifixion, He had also planned the current threats against His witnesses in the early church.
