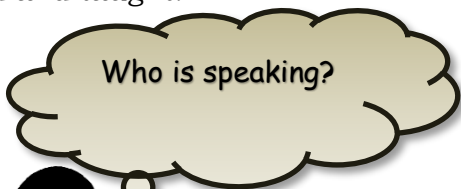
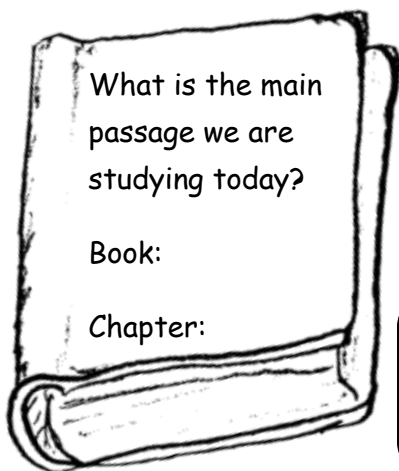

Read: *Genesis 3:15*

Today, we will read one of the three promises about Jesus in the book of *Genesis*. Adam sinned. He rebelled against the Creator God and disobeyed the command about the tree of the knowledge of good and evil. Man became a sinner, would die, and face judgment after this. But God, who is rich in mercy, promised to send a 2nd Adam—the Christ—Who would save man from his sins.

Pray

Dear LORD God, You are a loving LORD who cares about the people You have made. Thank You, Father, for not leaving us in our sins, helpless, and separated from You. I praise You for being such a forgiving and good God.

Application

- Say the memory verse to mom, dad, or older sibling.

Read: *Genesis 49:10; Numbers 24:17; 2 Samuel 7:12-17; Luke 1:30-33*

Today, we will read one of the three promises about Jesus in the book of *Genesis*. This Bible verse shows us that through Jacob's (Israel's) son the Savior would also be a King. In fact, the Savior would be the King of all kings!

Pray

Dear LORD God, You appointed Jesus Christ, to judge and rule this world. I worship You, Jesus, and confess that You are the King of all kings, and the LORD of all lords.

I am so glad that King Jesus loved me and laid down His life for me. I love You, Jesus. You are my king!

- Say the memory verse to mom, dad, or older sibling.

Pray: Dear Father, help me to understand what I read in Your Word.

Read: *Genesis 3:15*

You have studied some very important promises of God this week that show why Jesus took on the flesh of a man. Jesus came to be a kind of 2nd Adam to undo and redeem people from the curse of the 1st Adam's sin.

Christmas is a time in which we celebrate the birth of the One from Heaven, who came to crush Satan's power and work. Part of believing in Christ is seeing Satan's desires "crushed" in your heart and mind.

Dear LORD God, give me a heart that wants what You want and that seeks to live my life for Your great glory.
